GREEK ROOTS

1. Ana-up, back again, along, through (analysis, anatomy, anagram)
2. Hyper- above, overly, beyond (hyperbole, hyperactive, hyperglycemia)
3. Hypo- under, below (hypochondriac, hypodermic, hypothesis)

LATIN ROOTS

1. Duco/ductum- draw, attract, lead (aqueduct, conduct, induct)
2. Ago/actum- do, act, drive, perform (act, agent, agile)
3. Pendo/pensum- hang down, weigh, consider, judge (pensive, suspend, suspense)
4. Super- on top, above, over (super, survive, superlative)
5. Sub- under, below, beneath (subscription, suburb, substitute)
6. Rumpo/ruptum- break, burst, split (abrupt, corrupt, erupt)
7. Pax/pacis- peace (peace, appease, pacific)
8. Specto/spectatum- to look at, see (inspect, spectator, perspective)
9. Vox/vocis- voice (voice, vowel, advocate)
10. Loquor/locutus- speak (loquacious, eloquent, colloquial)
